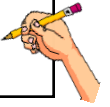

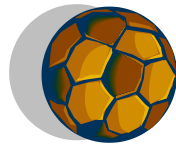

- ☉ Upon arrival at Pomona Elementary School, students will be given a snack and have recess. Students may attend one or two sessions from 3:45pm to 4:45pm and 4:45pm to 5:45pm.
- ☉ Parents will need to provide transportation home for their children or find approved alternate transportation. There is NO BUS HOME. All children must be picked up NO LATER THAN 6:00 PM. Parents will be charged \$1.00 per minute after.
